

# BEHAVIORAL BASED “NO-COST” ENERGY CONSERVATION PROGRAM



This course prepares participants to a proven zero-capital cost energy conservation program. The course is based on the *Energy STARS* program implemented by Albuquerque Public Schools during the past eight years.

The program was initiated by Albuquerque Public Schools M&O department in 2001 and in the 2007-2008 school year achieved over \$500,000 in electricity cost savings. The goal of the program is to realize 7-10% energy savings for your organization with no additional capital cost.

The course is aimed at public school officials, health care providers, apartment and office building managers and energy managers in public agency facilities. The goal of the program is to change the way people use energy in buildings by:

- **Teaching them about energy conservation**
- **Monitoring their energy consuming activities**
- **Giving them feedback about how much energy they are saving**
- **Recommending new energy saving activities**

Organizations can send one or more participants from their existing employee base to the training. A new employee does not need to be hired. This training will give your employee new skills to use in motivating all members of your organization to achieve energy savings through behavioral change. 12 hours plus 3 hour follow up class (15 total hour class time)
